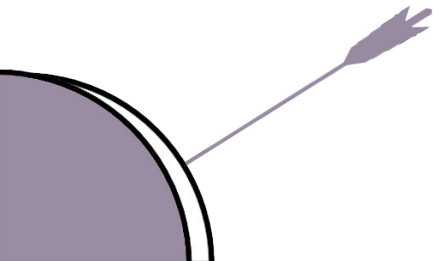

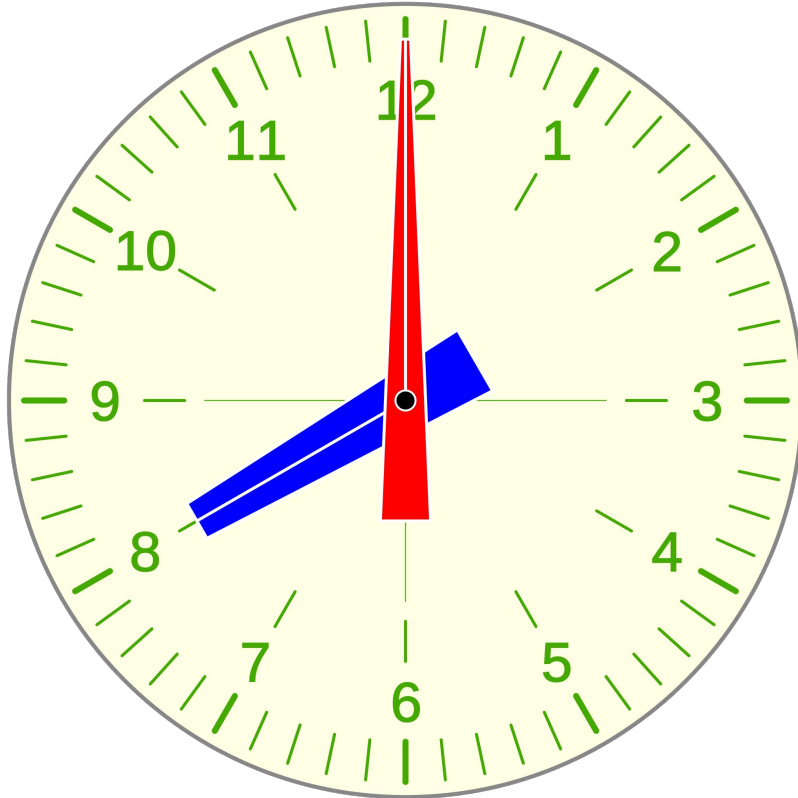

Transportation to/from Arlington Career Center



- **AM Courses**(1st/2nd Period at your Home School)
 - Bus will pick up from neighborhood Hub stop and drop off at Career Center
 - Shuttle bus from Career Center back to home school

- **MID-DAY Courses** (4th/5th or 5th/6th Period at your Home School)
 - Shuttle bus between Career Center & home school at beginning and end of class














- **PM Courses** (6th/7th or 7th/8th Period at your Home School)
 - Shuttle bus from home school to Career Center
 - Bus from Career Center to neighborhood Hub stop at the end of the day

The Career Center operates on an A and B day schedule with periods 1-5 only.

Parking at Career Center

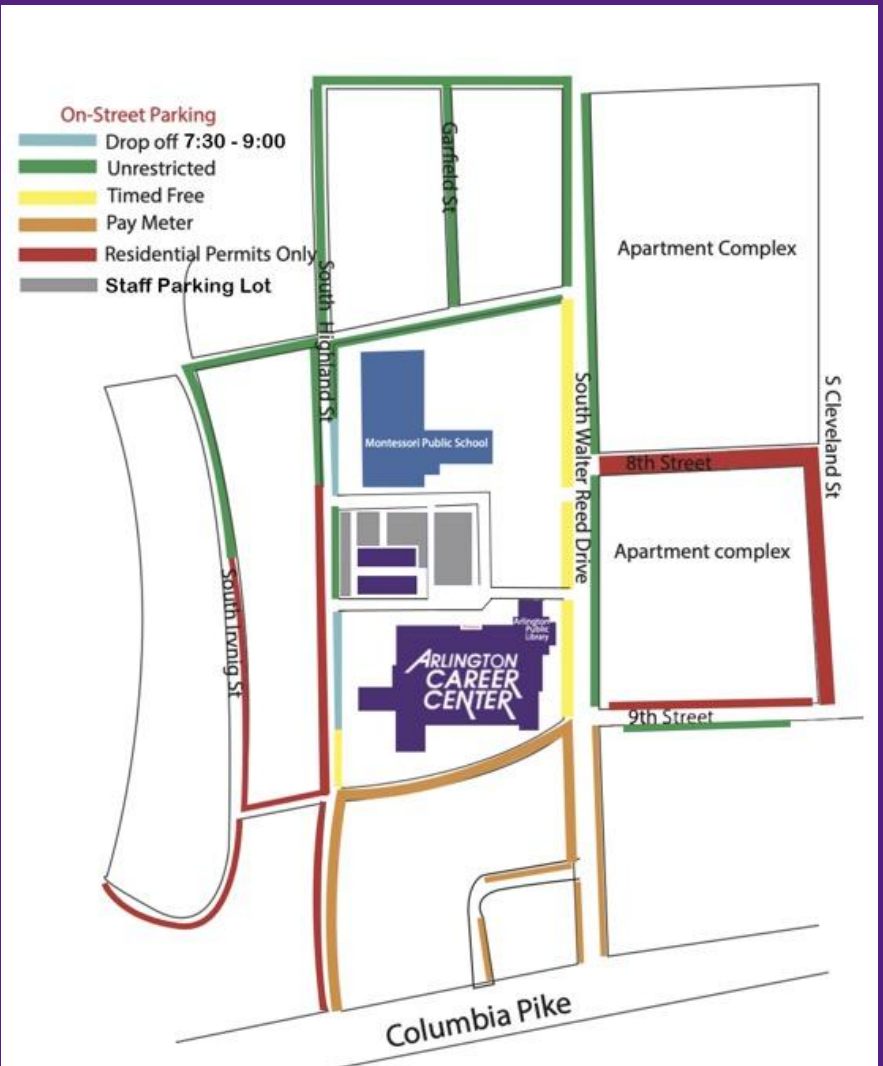


- Parking in the lot is not allowed

Parking at Career Center

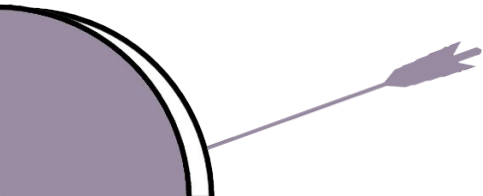
- Limited street parking is available around Career Center
- Students are encouraged to take the shuttle bus
- Students who choose to drive will not be excused for being late because of traffic or lack of parking



Cell Phones & Electronic Devices



- Cell phones and other electronics not issued by APS are to be turned off and away all day. If you bring a phone into the building, you are expected to leave it in your vehicle, backpack, or lab-assigned cubby while in the classroom and CTE lab spaces. Students are prohibited from using these devices in restrooms and dressing rooms unless there is a medical emergency.
- These items may be confiscated if they are on, out, in use, or are distracting from the learning environment.



Professional Dress



At the Career Center, we promote professionalism and workplace readiness.

To support this goal, we ask all students to dress professionally and appropriately.

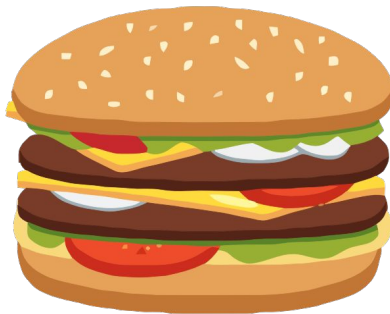
The following examples represent inappropriate professional dress:

- clothing that does not cover the buttocks or genitals,
- underwear worn without any clothes covering (visible waistbands or straps on undergarments worn under other clothing are acceptable)
- swimwear as standalone apparel (outside of pool areas)
- clothing with language or images that are vulgar, discriminatory, derogatory, or obscene.
- clothing that promotes the use of weapons, illegal acts or violence, drugs, alcohol/drug paraphernalia or gang involvement

Food at the Career Center



- Breakfast is available every morning from 7:30-8:00 AM
- Food may be consumed in any of the common areas with teacher permission
- To maintain a safe and professional environment, please do not bring food into classrooms or labs
- Ordering food from UberEats, GrubHub, etc. is not allowed. Food ordered through these means will be kept in the main office and returned to the student at the end of the day/period.



Pre-Arranged Absences



- If you know you will be absent for a school event (pep rally, sporting event, field trip, etc.), please let your teacher know ahead of time
- Your parent/guardian must call both your home school and the Career Center when you are going to be absent
